Fanny and Clift Richards were members of the Chevy Chase Literary Club

Fanny Otis Bartlett Richards (1868-1958) and Clift Rogers Richards (1867-1952). Fanny began her career as a teacher in an immigrant neighborhood in Boston. Clift was a student in Boston. Fanny was one of the four founders of the Chevy Chase Reading Class, and with her husband, an original member of the Chevy Chase Literary Club. Clift, a lawyer, worked for the Department of Interior, specializing in Indian Land Claims. The couple moved from the District of Columbia to 9 West Irving Street in 1898 where they lived the rest of their lives.
